



MADE SIMPLE



The theme of the Bible is how God will redeem His prized creation: mankind

The relationship between God and man was perfect in the Garden of Eden (Gen. 2:5-9; 3:8)

However sin caused spiritual death and resulted in being banned (Is. 59:2; Gen. 3:22-24)

The Story of the Bible:

MADE SIMPLE

Like Adam and Eve, we *have all sinned and fallen short* of God's glory (Rom. 3:23)

But God loves mankind and is able to save us all from our sins (Is. 59:1)

God would give promises and clues to the coming of man's opportunity for salvation

The Story of the Bible:

MADE SIMPLE

The Savior would crush the head of Satan, but also receive a blow to the heel (Gen. 3:15)

Through Abraham, all of the nations of the world would be blessed (Gen. 22:18)

It was promised to Judah the scepter would not depart (Gen. 49:10)

A sacrificial lamb was required for the Lord to pass over and was commemorated with a feast (Ex. 12:5-14)

The Story of the Bible:

MADE SIMPLE

God would raise another prophet like Moses and He will teach them God's commandments (Deut. 18:15-19)

God will raise a faithful priest, and will be given a sure house (1 Sam. 2:35)

God promised David his throne would be established forever and a descendant will rule (2 Sam. 7:8-16)

God will lay a sure foundation with a cornerstone in order to annul the people's covenant with death (Is. 28:15-18)

The Story of the Bible:

MADE SIMPLE

The Redeemer would come to Zion (Jerusalem) to save those who will repent (Is. 59:20)

The Savior would be made to suffer (Psalm 22:14-18, Is. 53:4-10)

The Holy One would not corrupt in death (Ps. 16:10)

The Lord would usher in a new covenant (Jer. 31:31-34)

The kingdom would prevail over all others and will never fail (Dan. 2:31-45)

Jesus is the fulfillment of the promises (Acts 3:17-26)

Prophet (Acts 3:22)

Priest (Heb. 7:20-28)

King (Heb. 2:5-9)

Resurrected from the dead (Acts 2:24-31, I Cor. 15:3-4)

Jesus is the fulfillment of the promises (Acts 3:17-26)

The Passover Lamb (I Cor. 5:7)

The chief cornerstone (Acts 4:11)

Mediator of the new covenant (Heb. 9:13-17)

Destroyer of the works of the devil (I Jn. 3:8)

The Story of the Bible:

MADE SIMPLE

The church is the kingdom and will stand for the rest of time (Col. 1:13, 18-20, Heb. 12:28-29)

The story of the Bible is simple:

Man decides to sin and separates himself from God (Is. 59:2)

God loves mankind and sent Jesus to die to atone for our sins (1 Jn. 4:10)

Will we obey and be added to His church? (Col. 1:21-23)

The Story of the Bible:

MADE SIMPLE

Rom. 6:23: For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Luke 13:3: No, I tell you; but unless you repent, you will all likewise perish.

Acts 22:16: And now why do you wait? Rise and be baptized and wash away your sins, calling on His name.

Acts 4:12: And there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.
